



## Proper Care of Lock Finishes

Proper care and maintenance will prevent deterioration of finish  
Please refer to the following guidelines

C3 and C3PVD	Polished Brass	Use a mild non abrasive detergent with damp sponge, then dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C5	Antique Brass	Use a mild non abrasive detergent with damp sponge, then dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C15	Satin Nickel	Use a mild non abrasive detergent with damp sponge, then dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C17A	Antique Nickel	Use a mild non abrasive detergent with damp sponge, then dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C19	Matte Black	Use a mild non abrasive detergent with damp sponge, then dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C26	Polished Chrome	Use a mild non abrasive detergent with damp sponge, then dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C26D	Satin Chrome	Use a mild non abrasive detergent with damp sponge, then dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C10B+	Aged Bronze	Use lemon oil, polish with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C32D	Satin Stainless Steel	Use a mild non abrasive detergent with damp sponge, then dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C9/26D	Polished Bronze and Satin Stainless Steel	Use Plastic Pad or bronze wool. Protect with a metal polish or car wax. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
C3W	Polished Brass and White Enamel	Use a mild non abrasive detergent with damp sponge, then dry with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, bleach, solvents, steel or bronze wool
